# Men's Basketball League

## Rules & Responsibility of Players & Captains

- 1. AWARDS: No awards for Pre-Season.
  - ➤ League: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place will receive a trophy.
  - > Tournament: 1st place trophy.
- 2. **UNIFORMS**: All players are encouraged to have matching shirts with numbers.
- 3. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Players must be 18 years of age or older. If under the age of 18, a parent or guardian **MUST** sign a release waiver at the WRD office for the player to participate.
- 4. **CONDUCT:** See "Player Code of Conduct".

### 5. GAME DAYS & TIME/FORFEIT:

- Figure 2. Games will be on Saturdays. If needed, there may be some Wednesday games. Please be early.
- (2) 20-minute halves. 5-minute half time. Each team will have 2-timeouts per half with no carry over. All timeouts are 1 minute.
- Running clock. Except for the last (2) minutes if the game is within a 15-point difference.
- Overtime will be (3) minutes, Jump ball, 1 timeout per team.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled game time.
- A team will be allowed a 10-minute grace period. At that time, a forfeit will be called. The team that is there to play will receive the win. (At the end of the season WRD will average the score & number of games the winning team has to be able to give them points for the game).
- If for some reason you will be unable to field a team, please notify the opposing team and Weiser Recreation (208) 414-0301 in advance.

#### 6. ROSTERS:

- Rosters should be turned in prior to the first scheduled game for each team. Rosters will become frozen after each team's final regular season game.
- ➤ If players are added to your roster after the first scheduled game, there will be a \$20.00 **per player charge**. NO EXCEPTIONS (If you do not turn in a full roster and add anyone after the first game the \$20.00 per player charge will apply). Teams may have up to 10 players on their roster.
- ➤ Each player on the roster MUST play in at least 3 league games to be eligible to participate in the tournament.

#### 7. PLAYERS:

- If you do not have enough players to make a team of (5), your team can play with (4) players. But less than 4 original players your team will forfeit the game. The opposing team can still play with 5 players.
- The pick-up player MUST be on a WRD Adult Men's Basketball rostered team.
- Pick-up players must be substituted if your original player shows up, you must play your rostered player.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in a forfeit.
- Teams may AGREE to allow more pick-up during league play ONLY.

#### 8. NO PICKUP PLAYERS DURING THE TOURNAMENT

9. <u>ONLY PLAYERS</u> are allowed on the bench. <u>NO CHILDREN OR SPECTATORS</u> are allowed on the bench for safety reasons.

#### 10. **FOULS**

- First offense: Verbal and/or violent, will result in a technical and will automatically bench the player for a **minimum** of (4) minutes. If the player commits another foul (verbal and/or violent), the player MUST leave the game and MAY NOT play in the next game.
- Technical fouls will be counted as personal and team fouls and will be kept track of during the season. IF A PLAYER HAS (4) TECHNICALS, PLAYER IS OUT OF THE PROGRAM. To be able to play again in the WRD program, player must go in front of the WRD board and plead their case.
- Gym supervisor, bookkeeper, and officials may ask any player to leave the gym. If said player will not leave, the Weiser Police Department will be called.
- 11. <u>PROFANITY RULE</u>: REFEREES ARE IN CHARGE. <u>YOU WILL NOT</u> argue or verbally harass them. There is a ZERO TOLERENCE POLICY effective immediately. Scorekeepers & Bookkeepers are also authorized to observe and advise the referee of any conduct violations committed by any player.
- 12. <u>DRUGS OR ALCOHOL</u>: Absolutely no drugs or alcohol are allowed on school property. If <u>ANY</u> Player is caught with any alcohol or drugs/paraphernalia in the gym or on school property, the Weiser Police will be called on player. They will be terminated from the league and will not be reinstated for this league. We cannot take the chance of losing the School Facilities. Players and Spectators: If anyone is suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol the Weiser Police will be called.
- 13. **PROTEST:** Game protests will only be considered under the following conditions:
  - > Game officials and the opposing manager are notified immediately AFTER the game.
  - No protest will be considered unless submitted in writing to the Recreation Director within 48 hours of the protested game. A \$50.00 protest fee must accompany the protest. If the protest is upheld a partial refund may be issued (\$25.00).
- 14. <u>FEES:</u> Must be paid in full by first game NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 15. <u>MILITARY EXCEPTION:</u> If a player is called out to training or for any other military reasons. Said player will not be held to the 3-league game rule for the tournament.

Any player <u>Dunking or Hanging on the rims</u> will be removed from the league. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!</u> Captains are responsible to let each player on their team know this rule.
