Electric Distribution System Ground Person
Job Duties

The Electric Distribution System Ground Person works under the supervision of the Electric Department Supervisor. They operate equipment, perform labor tasks, ensure system reliability to affect upgrades and service extensions as scheduled. In addition, they work to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the City's electrical distribution system, support maintenance activities, assist in equipment installations, and protect infrastructure.

General Duties/Responsibilities:

The following duties are standard for this job. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Assists in implementing and maintaining proper grounding procedures during maintenance, installation, and repair.
- Performs the maintenance, inspection, and installation of electrical distribution equipment.
- Conducts regular inspections of electrical systems.
- Assists in responding to electrical emergencies.
- Maintains accurate records of maintenance activities.
- Stays informed on industry regulations, safety procedures.
- Works collaboratively with other City personnel.
- Installation, maintenance, and repair of overhead transformers and transformer banks, air breaker switches, capacitor banks, fuse cutouts, lighting arrestors, cross arm conductors, down guys, and associated pole hardware.
- Installation, maintenance, and repair of underground distribution systems including conduit conductors, pad mount transformers, sector cabinets, splice boxes, pole risers, load break elbows, and terminations.
- Installation of electric meter hook-ups for power consumption recording, both self-contained and C.T.

Desired Skills/Abilities:

- 2 years on the job work experience in electrical distribution, construction, and maintenance.
- Prior experience in the electrical utility industry or a related field is a plus.
- Knowledge of electrical distribution, grounding principles, and safety regulations is a plus.
- Idaho Class B Commercial Driver's License. CDL required at 6 months of employment.
- Knowledge of tools and equipment, work practices and materials used in the construction and maintenance of electrical distribution systems including bucket trucks, digger derrick, backhoes, dump trucks, wire pullers, and tensioners.

Education and Experience:

- High School Diploma or equivalent GED.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Valid driver's license and willingness to travel within city limits as needed for job duties.

Working Conditions:

- Position requires sitting, standing, walking, reaching, twisting, turning, kneeling, bending, squatting and stooping in the performance of daily activities.
- Ability to use body and hands for tasks, walking, and lifting. Coordination needed for operating machinery and equipment. Personal protective equipment required. Ability to twist and turn. Safety first.
- Performance of essential functions may require exposure to adverse environmental conditions, such as dirt, dust, pollen, odors, wetness, humidity, rain, fumes, temperature and noise extremes, machinery, vibrations, electric currents, traffic hazards, or agents.
- The ability to communicate including talking, hearing, and listening.
- Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
