C. Utility Bills: The city utility bills will be billed in two (2) cycles, the first cycle being mailed on the fifteenth day of each month and the second being mailed on the thirtieth of each month.

The first cycle, mailed on the fifteenth of each month, will be delinquent on the first day of the month following. Any payments made after four o'clock (4:00) P.M. on the first day of the month, shall incur a late fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00). If the first day of the month falls on a holiday or weekend, the payment must be received by four o'clock (4:00) P.M. on the last working day before the first. Any utilities not paid in full by eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. on the fifth day after the delinquent date, will be disconnected.

The second cycle, mailed on the thirtieth of each month, will be delinquent on the fifteenth day of the month following. Any payments made after four o'clock (4:00) P.M. on the fifteenth day of the month, shall incur a late fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00). If the fifteenth day of the month falls on a holiday or weekend, the payment must be received by four o'clock (4:00) P.M. on the last working day before the fifteenth. Any utilities not paid in full by eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. on the fifth day after the delinquent date, will be disconnected.

Delinquent notices and shutoff tags will no longer be sent out by the city.

If utilities are disconnected, there will be a disconnect fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) and a reconnect fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00). The current bill and any fees must be paid in full before the service will be reconnected. There is an after hours fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) between the hours of five o'clock (5:00) P.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) A.M., and on weekends and holidays.

The city clerk may, at his/her discretion, extend the payment due date under special situations. These situations may include serious injury, illness or death in the immediate family.

This extension can be no longer than seven (7) days and will be by written agreement only. No verbal agreements will be accepted. There will be a five dollar (\$5.00) charge for this extension, in addition to the fifteen dollar (\$15.00) late penalty

Utility Bills: The city utility bills are billed in one (1) billing cycle. The Utility bills will be mailed out on the thirtieth of each month and will be due by the fifteenth of the following month. Any payment made after the fifteenth will receive a fifteen-dollar (\$15.00) late fee. If the fifteenth falls on a holiday or weekend, the payment must be made by the following business day. Any utilities not paid in full by eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. on the twenty-third will be disconnected. If the twenty-third falls on a holiday or weekend utilities would be disconnected the following business day.

Delinquent notices will not be sent out by the city of Weiser. If utilities are disconnected, there will be a disconnect fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) and a reconnect fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00). The current bill and any fees must be paid in full before the service will be reconnected. There is an after hours fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) between the hours of five o'clock (5:00) P.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) A.M., and on weekends and holidays.
